A couple tips:

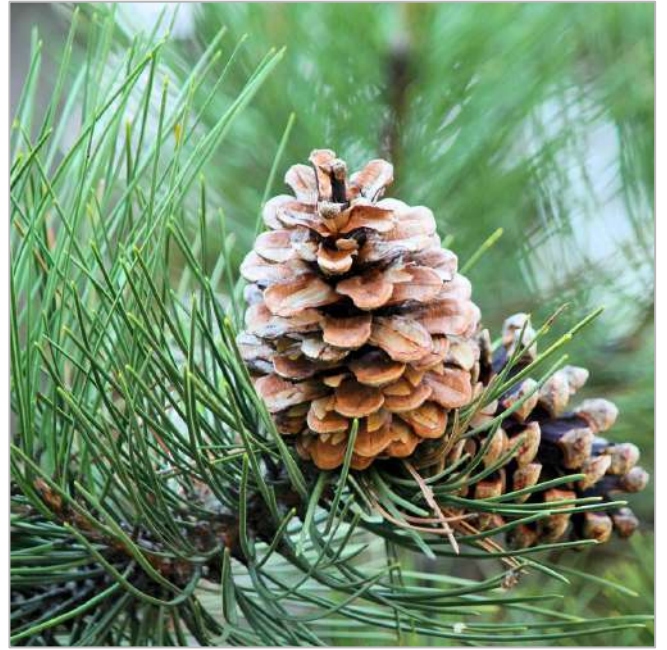
- To make the cards last longer, you could laminate them or print them on sturdy paper.
